Dear Ms. Avila:

The State Board of Equalization (BOE) has provided the following information regarding various educational matters and pertinent updates in preparation for the California Assessors' Association (CAA) Education Committee meeting on April 23, 2025.

The BOE's training schedule for the 2024-25 fiscal year is near completion. We scheduled 31 courses and three webinars, consisting of multiple sessions for 11 in-person and virtual classes. In addition, eight courses were planned for Orange, Sacramento, Santa Clara, and Yolo counties for their staff, utilizing county instructors.

We are in the process of setting the training schedule for the 2025-26 fiscal year. The Training Needs Survey was sent to the training coordinators on March 7<sup>th</sup> and was due on April 4<sup>th</sup>. We are reviewing the results and considering the feedback for the course offerings in the upcoming fiscal year.

- Orange County taught Course 56, *Advanced Sales Comparison & Income Approaches to Value*, on January 6-10, 2025.

Please note that we continually strive to update and modernize our course material. We welcome feedback and critique if specific content needs improvement or if any errors are noted in the material so we can promptly address them.

## Training and Certification – Course Updates

We have offered an increase in the course capacity for numerous virtual courses this fiscal year. Based on the results, we will continue to expand the course capacity for the virtual core classes with a higher waitlist count. To maintain the increase in course capacity, we will focus on prerequisites to improve the pass rate and ensure the students are adequately prepared. Please see below for important course updates.

#### Recruitment of County Instructors:

BOE sent out a County Assessors Only Letter (2024/025) on October 8, 2024, requesting qualified county instructors willing to teach BOE courses to expand the number of course offerings. We received a response from one county with two eligible candidates; one has been certified. This is an ongoing request for counties to respond and designate qualified staff.

#### Open Book Exams:

In response to the committee's request, the BOE has offered open-book exams for Courses 5 and 56 as a trial program for the fiscal year. Below are the statistics for the courses that have been completed to date:

The results have determined that the open-book exams were successful based on the data gathered for the fiscal year. We will continue to offer open-book exams for the advanced courses listed above and will begin for Course 18 in the upcoming fiscal year.

#### April 2025 Training Reports:

Revenue and Taxation Code1 section 671 requires holders of an appraiser's certificate to complete at least 24 hours of BOE conducted or approved training each year; only 12 hours are required for holders of advanced certificates. Similarly, section 674 requires holders of an assessment analyst's certificate to complete at least 24 hours of BOE-conducted or approved training each year; only 12 hours are required for holders of advanced certificates.

On April 8, 2025, training coordinators were notified via email that 2024-2025 fiscal year training reports were posted to the Assessor Portal. The information in these reports reflects all BOE-conducted training courses, workshops, and WebEx sessions completed by April 1, 2025, and all other BOE-approved training, as reported on BOE-744-A, *Request for Training Hours*, that was submitted to the BOE by April 1, 2025.

#### Conference Training Hours:

At recent conferences, there has been a discussion that participants in both virtual meetings and in-person meetings have not received credits for their hours of attendance. We recognize these hours are important for meeting the annual requirement under Revenue and Taxation Code sections 671(a) and 671(b)(3) for permanent and advanced appraiser certificates. We coordinated with the CAA management team to improve the sign-in sheets and the overall process for collecting attendance more efficiently for in-person and Zoom attendance to reflect the training hours promptly. Please note that it is important to follow the sign-in instructions for Zoom participants to ensure that the names are included in the list and that the virtual attendees receive the hours.

#### **Online Training:**

On the BOE website, 46 self-study courses on various topics are available for continued training. Students may complete the training at their own pace, answer the review questions, and submit the document for grading to receive a certificate and training hours. We also offer a self-paced online appraisal course. Course 5, *Income Approach to Value*, is available on our website to complete for credit at any time.

#### Course Modernization Project:

We are commencing a project to convert our BOE courses to a web-based platform utilizing Canvas Learning Management System (LMS) by Instructure to offer self-paced online training. We are in the beginning phase, but our team is working diligently to transfer the material to this modernized platform. We anticipate a two-year timeline for rolling out the courses. We will also be offering webinars and self-studies on this platform. On March 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025, we recorded the presentation of the Geothermal Webinar, and we are working with our partner agency, CDTFA's Media Services Team, to use the recording to offer repeat sessions for training hours. The BOE continues seeking current technology to provide innovative and modernized training.

The CAASA Education Committee held their annual meeting via zoom on April 9, 2025. During the meeting they discussed the following:

- Cutting the annual fee for counties that train CAASA trainings. If the trainer backs out the county will be billed the annual fee.

• Would any counties be interested in attending an offering of IAAO Course 400 – Assessment Administration hosted by the LA County Chapter of IAAO and the LA County Assessor's Office? The course is geared towards management and supervisory personnel and focuses on the need for management, and the responsibilities placed on the assessor and all supervisory staff. The course would be onsite at the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration in downtown LA and would be held over a four-day period with an online exam to be taken at the individual attendee's leisure. It is the first course needed to acquire an IAAO designation of Assessment Administration Specialist. The fee for the course would be nominal and simply entail the cost for the course material, since LA County's staff will be instructing. Cost would be approx. \$400 per course plus travel for a 4-day class. There are 2-4 core classes. Some pre-requisites are online.

Next Real Property Chief's fall conference is in Merced at the El Capitan Hotel.
